**To be read and signed by youth and parents:**

1. A ratio of at least 7:1, youth: advisors, will be maintained throughout the event.
  2. Each youth will provide a signed permission slip/medical form and a signed behavioral agreement.
  3. Each youth or adult participant will act in accordance with the seven UU principles.
  4. All advisors and volunteers will abide by the UUA Code of Ethics for Adults Working with Children and Youth. They will support youth and protect the best interests of youth and the congregation.
  5. No alcohol, drugs, weapons, violence, sexual, disrespectful or illegal behavior will be allowed.
  6. Participants will protect the integrity and safety of each person.
  7. "The No Rule" applies; all participants will back up youth or adults who indicate discomfort with the words or actions of others, by requesting that the words or actions be stopped or altered to be acceptable.
  8. All participants will remain with the group and strive to honor group covenant, if one is written.
  9. Participants will respect church property and the property of others. They will offer help with clean up.
  10. Advisors will consult with one another regarding any violations of these guidelines, responding as a team. If there is a serious infraction, parents may be notified, and they may be asked to pick up their youth at their own expense. Other authorities will be notified where there has been illegal activity.
  11. Be present and kind. Make connections and be supportive of youth, adults, and the event.
