In 2002, with the support of the Board of Directors of our church, our Senior Minister Victoria Safford made public her decision to sign no marriage certificates for heterosexual couples until the rights and privileges such documents afford are made available to gay and lesbian couples as well. This witness for marriage equality continued as a practice of our ministry staff, until the passage of marriage equality in Minnesota in 2013.
